October 2013

October 2015

Launches "America's Biggest Health Fair," now known as "Walmart Wellness Day" to provide free blood glucose, blood pressure, vision screenings, health insurance information and immunizations at 4,400 U.S. stores.

September 2019

The first Walmart Health clinic opens in Dallas, Ga.

June 2020

Partners with Humana and Quest Diagnostics to expand COVID-19 testing for its members by opening 500 testing locations at Walmart pharmacies.

Acquires technology platform CareZone.

October 2020

Begins selling Medicare plans via its new insurance brokerage agency, Walmart Insurance Services.

Partners with Medicare Advantage insurer Clover Health on its first insurance plan with open provider networks, free primary care visits, lab tests and preventive dental exams.

October 2014

Announces "Healthcare Begins Here" program, providing DirectHealth.com licensed agents at local stores to help consumers shop for health insurance and navigate Obamacare's health insurance exchanges.

August 2018
